Requirements to be listed on the Frontier Barn Quilt Trail.

- Quilt blocks must be approved by the Barn Quilt Trail Committee in order to maintain continuity, to eliminate duplication and insure quality.
- Quilts must be painted on approved sign board or directly on barn/building.
- Quilts must be placed on committee approved barn, building or other location.
- The block cannot include a company logo, lettering, nor can the installed block be used as a company logo.
- Clear space around each quilt block must meet the following blank space:
 - 1' space around 2 x2
 - 2' space around 4 x 4
 - 4' space around 8 x 8 blocks.
- Location of barn/building must be visible from road for public viewing and in a location that will
 prevent traffic congestion or safety concerns.
- The barn/building will be visible without obstruction of trees, crops, or other buildings during all seasons.
- Barn quilts installed on barns/buildings must be visible from public roads in Fulton County.
- Churches, Mosques or Synagogues or any other religious facilities or their affiliates are not permitted to participate in the Frontier Barn Quilt Trail.
- The quilt block will be screwed, bolted or painted directly to the building in a permanent manner.
- All paint must be supplied by each host. If the host chooses to have the Frontier Barn Quilt Trail of Fulton Co., PA select the paint, the host must accept full responsibility for the selection of color, tint, hue and brightness. At the completion of the block, all left over paint will be returned to the host. Also, the host will be billed for the paint at actual cost not to exceed \$25 per quart. (Quarts are the smallest size available.)

If your barn/building meets most but not all of the criteria, it may still be approved by the committee. Each application will be reviewed individually. We encourage anyone interested to complete an application for review by the committee.



Frontier Barn Quilt Block Kits For Sale

If you are a "Do it Yourselfer" these kits provide the materials and instructions to build your own barn quilt block. Each kit includes high quality materials and the assistance of a Frontier Barn Quit Trail advisor to assist in your pattern selection, which is typically the most difficult part of the project.

Barn Quilt Block Kit

These kits come complete with materials and instructions. Note: Paint is not part of the kit

2' x 2' unframed = \$ 65.00

4' x 4' unframed = \$100.00

8' x 8' unframed = \$200.00

8' x 8' fully framed = \$275.00

(For installations where the wall is not perfectly flat, we highly recommend a framed quilt block.)

Kits contain special pre-primed MDO exterior sign board, exterior screws, wood filler, mounting brackets, painting and taping supplies. Hardware provided is for attachment to wood siding only. Structures of other material will require special fasteners not included in kit.

Also included are step by step instructions with tips and techniques, how to choose a pattern, color, layout and painting tips as well as installation suggestions and other useful information.

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
